Alessandra Lemma

Keynote speaker

Professor Alessandra Lemma is a Fellow of the British Psychoanalytic Society and Consultant Clinical Psychologist at the Anna Freud National Centre for Children and Families. She is Visiting Professor, Psychoanalysis Unit, University College London. For many years she worked at the Tavistock Clinic where she was, at different points, Head of Psychology and Professor of Psychological Therapies. She was the Editor of the New Library of Psychoanalysis book series (Routledge) until 2020 and was one of the regional Editors for the International Journal of Psychoanalysis until 2018. She has published extensively on psychoanalysis, the body, trauma and the psychic impact of new technologies.

Evie Athanassiadou

Round table speaker

Clinical Psychologist, Child and Adolescent-Psychotherapist. Vice President of the Hellenic Association of Child and Adolescent Psychoanalytic Psychotherapy. Currently working as an external supervisor at "Aghia Sophia" Children's Hospital Child Psychiatric Clinic, University of Athens Medical School and "The Smile of the Child" Day Hospital for abused children. She has worked as a psychoanalytic psychotherapist in residential settings, and head of a helpline for children and adolescents. She has taught in graduate and postgraduate programs in collaboration with Tavistock clinic and East London University and University of Athens Department of Clinical Psychology. She is a teacher of theoretical and clinical seminars and infant observation in Athens. She has published in Greek and English. She is also in private practice in Athens.

Alessandra Chinaglia

Psychologist – Psychoanalytic Psychotherapist, Psychiatric Social Worker. President of Soci Italiani EFPP from 2020. For many years worked at Public Psychiatric Service in Venice. She trained since 1978 at the Hampsted Clinic (Anna Freud Centre now). She had seminars with Anna Freud, supervision with Adam Limentani, Egle and Moses Laufer and Vera Pettitt with whom she collaborated in a research project in DCA disturbances. She is a member of FT in the SIPP (Società Italiana di Psicoterapia Psicoanalitica). She was coordinator of Supervisors SIPP in Italy. Also, Adjunct Professor of Dynamic Psychology, School of Spe-

cialization of Psychology of the Life Cycle, Università degli Studi di Padova, 2003 - 2013. She has many publications; among them "Architecture and psychoanalysis. Nathaniel Kahn and the search for the father" (with A. Cornoldi), International Forum of Psychoanalysis, 2018, and also Ritorno al Mare (poems) foreword by Francesco Semi, Pisa, Editore Giardini, 1978.

Mary Morgan

Mary Morgan is a Psychoanalyst and Couple Psychoanalytic Psychotherapist, Fellow of the British Psychoanalytical Society, Senior Fellow of Tavistock Relationships and Honorary Member of the Polish Society for Psychoanalytic Psychotherapy. She is European member of the IPA Committee in Couple and Family Psychoanalysis.

Until recently she was the Reader in Couple Psychoanalysis and Head of the MA in Couple Psychoanalytic Psychotherapy at Tavistock Relationships, London. She has written extensively in field of couple psychoanalysis, teaches and supervises internationally and has a private analytic practice. Her book: "A Couple State of Mind: Psychoanalysis of Couples – the Tavistock Relationships Model" was published recently by Routledge.

Gila Ofer

Gila Ofer, Ph.D is clinical psychologist, training psychoanalyst and group analyst. She has a BA in English and French literature, M.A and PhD in clinical psychology. Dr. Ofer is the founder and past president of The Tel-Aviv Institute of Contemporary Psychoanalysis (TAICP) and a founding member of The Israeli Institute of Group Analysis (IIGA) and she serves on the faculty of both institutes of the Post-Graduate School for Psychoanalytic Psychotherapy, Tel-Aviv University. Dr. Ofer has been the chair of the group analytic section and board member of the EFPP, and later a conjoint member of the board as the coordinator of Eastern European countries of the EFPP. Dr. Ofer is the editor of the EFPP Psychoanalytic Psychotherapy Review. Her edited book "A Bridge over Troubled Water: Conflicts and reconciliation in Group and Society" was published on 2017.

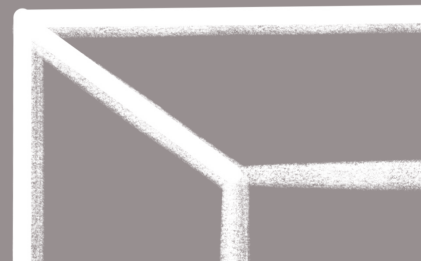
